



Note:

THEORY: One Credit Hour shall be equal to one hour of teaching per week throughout the semester.

PRACTICAL / LAB: One Credit Hour shall be equal to two hours of lab work per week throughout the semester.

CLINICAL: One Credit Hour shall be equal to three hours of clinical work per week throughout the semester.

RESEARCH: One credit hour shall be qual to three hours of research work per week throughout the semester.



Teaching System of BIPRS

MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

All text books, lectures, instruction will be in English medium only.

TEACHING SYSTEMS

Integrated teaching Curriculum and semester teaching systems are followed by the college under the affiliation of RIPHAH International University Islamabad. Uniqueness of system lies under the fact that students can learn. Accordingly their performance is assessed by various tests and examinations which are conducted throughout their stay in Institute.

ACADEMIC SESSION

Consists of two semesters of 16 weeks per year. Out of the 16 weeks, 14 weeks are allocated for studies while 2 weeks are allocated For preparation leave.

First semester teaching starts with day one of semester

One week's leave is allocated as winter vacation.

ATTENDANCE

75% attendance is compulsory for students appearing for semester exams.

TYPE OF EXAMINATIONS

On completion of all necessary syllabus there will be a semester examination at the end of semester. Semester examinations are divided into two sections.

1. Pattern of Examination

- A) For Basic & Rehabilitation Subjects
 - a) Multiple Choice Questions
 - b) Practical, Viva Voices (BCQ's)
- B) For Allied / Social Science Subjects.
 - a) MCQs (50%)
 - b) Short Essays (30%)
 - c) Long Question (20%)

Withdrawal of Course and Grade 'W'

- 1. A student shall be allowed to withdraw from a course 2 weeks before the end of the classes in the semester subject to the approval by the course teacher and Dean concerned. The withdrawn courses shall appear on the transcript with letter grade 'W'. For the courses with co-requisites (for example, courses with theory as well as lab work), if a student withdraws one component of such a course then it shall be deemed as he/she has withdrawn the whole course.
- The student may repeat the withdrawn course whenever offered net. He/she shall attend all the classes / tutorials and shall appear in all quizzes/mid semester test(s) assignment(s)/group the end of the semester/session.
- 3. He/she shall pay the semester dues for repeating the withdrawal course(s).

Grade 'F'

- If a student fails to appear in the terminal examination of course, he/she be treated as absent and failed.
- The minimum pass marks for each course shall be 50. A student obtaining less than 50 marks in any course shall be deemed to have failed in the course.
- 3. Whenever a students fails in a course, he/she shall repeat the course as soon as the course is offered to improve his/her grade. He/she is required to attend all the classes / tutorial and shall appear in all quizzes/ mid semester test (s)/ assignment(s)/ group discussion(s)/ presentations projects(s) during the semester and terminal examination at the end of the semester.
- He/she shall pay the dues for repeating the failed course(s).

Repeating Courses

- A student may be allowed to repeat a course in which he/she has obtained grade "D", "F" or "W" to improve his /her grade of the course.
- A student is required to attend all the classes/tutorial and shall appear in all quizzes/mid semester test(s)/ assignment(s) /group discussion(s)/ presentations project(s) during the semester and terminal examination at the end of the semester.
- He/she shall pay the dues for repeating the course(s).

Academic Deficiency

 A student shall be required to maintain a minimum CGPA of 2.0 throughout the period of study.

- 2. At the end of every regular semester, a probation warning is issued to the student if the CGPA of the student falls below 2.0. However, if a student cannot earn a minimum GPA of 1.0 in the first semester then he/she shall be dismissed from the program. In case GPA of a student in the first semester falls below 1.5 but equal to or above 1.0 then he/she shall be given a serious warning (the last chance to attain a semester GPA of 2.0 or above). A student on serious warning shall be dismissed from the program if he/she fails to achieve minimum semester GPA of 2.0.
- A student with a warning probation cannot register courses in the subsequent semester without the approval of the Dean.
- After each regular semester, if the CGPA of a student is less than the 2.0, the probation count increases by one.
- If the CGPA of the student equal or exceeds 2.0, the probation count become zero.
- 6. If the probation count of student become three (3), he/she shall be relegated. A relegated student shall not be allowed to register any new course (s) and only re-register his/her repeatable courses. During relegation he/she shall have to maintain a minimum CGPA of 2.00. To remove the relegation status he/she shall have to earn a minimum CGPA of 2.00. The relegation period shall be counted towards the maximum period allowed for the program.

Procedure of Admission

- Applications for admission in 1st year doctor of physiotherapy shall be invited through advertisement.
- Application of those candidates will be considered who shall appear in entry test.
- Admissions shall be carried on merit basis
