WELCOME TO MIRPURKHAS CITY



Mirpurkhas (Meaning: the land of the highest Mirs) is a city located in the province of Sindh. It is the 4th largest city of the Sindh province with an estimated population of 250,000. Its soil is fertile and the city is known as "the city of Mangoes and NGO's". For its horticultural farming of which the most celebrated is mango cultivation with hundreds of varieties produced each year, and hosting many organizations working in social sector.

It's positional atop and fertile land makes conditions apt for irrigation and farming. Being connected to the Indus River via irrigation canals, Mirpurkhas has gained an advantage in horticulture and farming over the years. Primary produce includes mangoes, sugarcane, wheat and chilies. Bananas are also widely cultivated around the region.

Prior to the Islamic conquest of Sindh, the land where Mirpurkhas now stands, used to be a thriving Bhuddhist settlement known as "Kahoo Jo Kot". The remnant Stupa still remains and is known as, "Kahoo Jo Daro". As the armies settled in the area, newer buildings occupied the land and led into massively progressive landscapes. Farming became known to people and horticulture and cotton fields blossomed.

In 1806, Mankani Talpurs laid the foundation for Mirpurkhas city under the leadership of Mir Ali Murad Talpur and his successor Mir Sher Muhammad Talpur (Lion of Sindh) and built a font when he was declared the ruler of the south of the state.

Mirpurkhas is the gateway to the south eastern edge of the Sindh province. It connects Tando Allahyar, Sanghar, Umerkot, Thar Parkar and Badin districts and happens to be economic and educational hub for the area. Mirpurkhas houses three degree Colleges, many higher secondary and primary schools, one Medical College, one dental college and Sindh University campus. It also has its own Board of secondary and higher secondary education. There is still a need of more institutions to cater for diverse disciplines of education.



TEACHING SYSTEM OF BDMC

Teaching System

DESCRIPTION

Physiology is the study of how the body works in health, more specifically, the science which deals with the functions of the human body and its parts, and of the physical and chemical factors and processes involved. It includes the study of living organisms from cell to system and whole body. Physiology provides a description of the normal functions of the major systems of the human body, like nervous system, cardiovascular, respiratory, endocrine, musculoskeletal, elementary, and the genitourinary systems and to discuss the role of these systems in the maintenance of internal homeostasis. The course provides a base for the study of all clinical subjects, especially pathology and medicine.

The department is committed to outstanding research and excellence in the delivery of up-to-date physiology education to health sciences professionals which include medical, dental, nursing and pharmacy students. The courses taught to the students of first professional BDS includes theoretical discussion in the form of lectures, seminars, tutorials and group discussions. The lectures are more understandable by the use of audiovisual aids like multimedia and slide projections. The theoretical description is supported by the relevant practical which caters to the needs of the students.

The department consists of a fully equipped laboratory to be used not only for the practical work related to Physiology but also for research. DESCRIPTION

The course of Anatomy includes Gross Anatomy of the Body, Neuroanatomy, Embryology and Histology of the basic tissues and organs as well as aspects of health and disease. The course is covered through lectures, tutorials, dissection and clinical exposures. Lectures are supported by transparency, slides and CD's. The department also provides anatomical models, dissected specimens and computer assisted learning. We offer a fully integrated approach to the study of human being. The different disciplines in anatomy are taught in relation to the function with emphasis on their usefulness in their clinical years of training. The training period and the number of hours for different disciplines are strictly in accordance with the recommendations of Pakistan Medical & Dental Council. Our instructional methods focus on the use of small group activities with the goals of increasing the amount of self-directed learning and acquiring the skills for the lifelong acquisition of knowledge.

Dissection Hall

DESCRIPTION

Medical Biochemistry is the study of the chemical processes occurring in human body. It deals with the structures and functions of cellular components such as proteins, carbohydrates, lipids, nucleic acids and other biomolecules. The main focus of Medical Biochemistry is in understanding how biological molecules give rise to the processes that occur within living cells which in turn relates greatly to the study and understanding of whole organisms. It begins with an introduction to the principles of the science and the structure and function of the various chemical elements that constitute living cells. Medical Biochemistry has uncovered the molecular evidences of almost all the diseases to-date.

It not only helps to understand the disease better but also provides the methods and tools for accurate diagnosis of the diseases which assist further treatment plans. Practical exercises in the laboratory form an essential mode of instruction. These are designed to illustrate concepts discussed in the class room and to introduce methods of biochemical analysis by various techniques used for separation, identification, and measurement of biomolecules relevant to clinical sciences.

The science of Pharmacology is concerned with the effects of drugs on the cellular mechanism, and the fate of drugs in the body. DESCRIPTION

The overall objective of the department/subject of Dental Public Health Sciences is to develop and setup approaches for doctors and dental students to get community oriented dental training, research motivation and to solve community health and related problems. Bhitai Dental and Medical College has made a major commitment to community oriented medical and dental education. The 2nd year BDS students are required to visit rural communities to achieve the objectives of the community survey, through family health folders as a survey module, about data generation and studying the socioeconomic, sanitary and health status of the population in the rural communities. In 3rd year, students are required to visit BHU's and rural health centers for their integrated training.

The overall intent is to provide students opportunities to use their general biomedical knowledge to benefit communities through improved community based health services and for them to develop an understanding and a capacity to deal effectively with the health problems of the deprived population. In the third year and fourth year, clerkship in community health sciences collaborate with the clinical Departments so that the students have the experience of practicing ambulatory and family medicines to participate in the research oriented projects, and evaluate the effectiveness of the primary health care system. At this stage, students are also introduced to critical appraisal of articles in journals, biomedical ethics and ethical issues that needed to be addressed in taking care of patients and communities.

In the study of oral and dental sciences, Oral Pathology is the subject that deals with the nature, identification and management of diseases affecting the oral and maxillofacial region. Understanding of oral pathology is essential for diagnosis and for the development of rational treatment and preventive programs as a dental professional must possess a good understanding of causative factors, disease processes, clinical presentation, microscopic features, and diagnosis of oral and Paraoral diseases. One of the most important purposes of oral pathology is to give the student the ability to correctly diagnose oral lesions and develop differential diagnosis. The department of Oral Pathology has educational goals for the 3rd year BDS students. The department provides an overview of oral and maxillofacial pathology including the clinical Histopathology and radiographic presentation of Oral diagnosis and pathogenesis. The study of microscope, tissue processing, diagnostic tests and advanced techniques are also includes.





The goals for the Department of Periodontology are to provide dental students with a high quality education, cultivate their abilities to provide evidence based periodontal treatment to their patients in a friendly and professional atmosphere; and to conduct a productive research to shape the future of periodontics.

This discipline deals with diseases of the gums. It is one of the first clinical subjects the undergraduate encounters in the dental course. Through the lectures, tutorials and clinical sessions, undergraduates study about the normal and pathological tissues of the periodontium as well as the etiology and classification of gingival and periodontal disease. Students in their third year treat patients with periodontal problems and are also given the opportunity to perform simple periodontal surgical procedures.



DESCRIPTION

Prosthodontics restores oral structures through the use of crowns, bridges, dentures and implants. The undergraduate prosthodontic program stretches over three years, beginning with the introduction to the concepts of prosthodontics as pre-clinical prosthodontics in second year. Pre-clinical prosthetics is taught during the first two years of BDS course. The college has fully developed and equipped junior prosthetic laboratory for pre-clinical students. Simple prosthodontics work is introduced in third year which basically involves removable partial dentures followed by more complex cases in final-year BDS. For clinical students college has separate senior prosthetic laboratory equipped with all the required teaching and training aids. State of the art prosthetic laboratory having equipment for removable cast partial denture and crown-bridge fabrication is a big facility for students as well as patients. The laboratory will soon step ahead to metal free restoration and veneers.

Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery (OMFS) is the specialty of Dentistry that encompasses the art and science of the diagnosis and surgical management of diseases, injuries, and defects of the Oral and Maxillofacial region. It is also designed to develop instinct to become a lifelong learner and take active part in Continual Dental Education (CDE) The course of oral surgery is designed such that the students are trained to diagnose the diseases, injuries, defect of jawbones and associated intra and extra-oral structures and to train the students to provide services of Oral Surgery for the management of patients in practice of general dentistry. Students are also trained to encounter oral surgical accidents, complications and preparation of patients for oral surgical procedures and post-operative care for simple and complicated tooth extractions.OPD has different minor Operation Theaters for Hepatitis patients and for minor surgical procedures which makes sure that there is no cross contamination and every patient is treated as a special case with meticulous sterilization. The procedures performed at our OPD are:

- Computerized National Identity Card of Father / Mother.
- Affidavits/undertakings on Rs.100/- stamp paper as per specimens given in the end of prospectus regarding not having got admission in any other Medical College or Medical University in the country or production of false documents. (These affidavits will be required at the time of Admission, if offered).
- Twelve passport size photographs bearing name and father name written on back (one posted in the space provided and five affixed on the front of application form).
- > Applications along with the attested photocopies of required documents shall be submitted in the prescribed printed form and its columns must be filled in correctly. Incomplete forms are liable to be rejected.
- > The Chairman of the Admission Committee shall announce the selection of any candidate, selected in accordance to the overall merit obtained by the candidates displaying the list on the Notice Board of
- > BDMC and on the website of BDMC.
- The Admission Committee shall have the discretion to cancel the admission of any candidate, who indulges in the violence; use abusive language becomes insolent or misbehaves with the Admission Committee.
- The Admission Committee shall not consider any candidate for admission if he/she is found involved in any kind of illegality, misrepresentation or fraud at any stage of admission/Selection process.
- The date admission in First year BDS course shall be taken to be the first day of the corresponding academic year, irrespective of the fact as to when candidate has been selected for admission in the institution.
- The rules and regulations for holding different professional examination for B.D.S. course shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations framed by the Pakistan Medical Commission (PMC) for the

REGULATIONS CONCERNING TO THE BEHAVIOR OF STUDENTS, PRESERVATION OF DISCIPLINE AND BREACH OF DISCIPLINE

Following regulations are prescribed to regulate the conduct of college students and the maintenance of discipline.

These regulations will apply to all students of the college, registered for any class. In these regulations the following expressions shall have the meanings as assigned to them unless there is anything repugnant to the context, will be:

"Student" means a student on the rolls of the college registered for any class.

"Indiscipline" means any act of indiscipline under these regulations that disturbs the order of the college or is derogatory to moral values or is otherwise declared this act.

"Disciplinary committee" means the disciplinary committee of the college.

"College privileges" means membership of an institution, library or committee, scholarships, or other concessions granted to students.

"Fine" means a monetary fine.

"Exclusion from activities" means exclusion for a specified period from activities or a specific area.

"Warning" means written notice that there has been a violation of specified college policies or campus regulations and that further disciplinary action can be triggered if continued or repeated.

"Suspension" means the termination of campus student status for a defined period.

"Rustication" means the withdrawal of a student from the college rolls for one or more years, or for the remainder of the current academic year in which the order is issued, and the withdrawal of the student from appearing at the subsequent terminal or final examination, or both.

"Expulsion" means the cancellation of admission of a student who has been debarred from readmission for at least one academic year.

RULES OF STUDENT CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOR

- 1. It is expected that all college students will work hard to seek knowledge, be regular and punctual in their academic work and strictly carry out their teacher's instructions to their satisfaction and the college authorities.
- 2. To promote an atmosphere of peace, discipline, and orderly conduct on campus, all students shall cooperate and have a good relationship with colleagues, teachers, and college staff.
- 3. Students must follow the dress code as defined in the college prospectus and are not permitted to wear ostentatious (real or artificial) jewelry, casual dresses, joggers, jeans, etc.
- 4. Students must pay college fees on time and return library books and should not harm the property and equipment of the college.
- 5. All college buildings and premises should be kept clean. Students are required on all campuses, including playgrounds, to observe strict discipline and attend non-curricular activities.
- 6. Students are not permitted to see any visitors during academic hours. Visitors can be welcomed on campus only after prior written permission given by the HOD/Dean to see any student.
- 8. No student gathering or meeting will be permitted at the college premises without prior permission from the Principal.
- 9. Students are not permitted to organize or attempt to organize or participate in a strike or to use pressure techniques against the college and to obstruct the exercise of legal authority.
- 10. Students are not permitted to engage in political activity or to seek participation in any political party
- 11. Students should seek permission to enter the administrative offices or staff room(s).

GROUNDS FOR DISCIPLINE

The following will be treated as acts of discipline violation.

- 1. All forms of academic misconduct, including cheating, fabrication, plagiarism, or the promotion of academic dishonesty.
- 2. Act of disrespect to teachers, visiting faculty, and college staff.
- 3. Any form of dishonesty, including supplying the college with false information or reporting a false emergency.
- 4. Forgery, alteration, or misuse of any record, key, electronic device, or identification of any college document.
- 5. Indulging in any activity that is detrimental to college prestige and honor.
- 6. Theft or misuse of college facilities, movable property, and other electronic assets.
- 7. Unauthorized possession or use, including the college name, insignia, or seal, of any college facilities.
- 8. Physical abuse, including conduct that threatens an individual's health or safety.
- 9. Obstruction or disruption in teaching, research, administration, disciplinary procedures, or other college activities,.
- 10. Lewd behavior and disorderly conduct, walkout, or strike.
- 11. Selling, preparing or distributing lecture notes or videos or audio recordings for any commercial purpose unless authorized by the college in advance.
- 12. Smoking, cigarettes, cigars, or any drug containing to bacco and the use of illicit substances.
- 13. Firearms or weapons, ammunition, explosives, knives, or other weapons or hazardous chemicals are possessed or used.
- 14. Any act of verbal, mental & physical harassment caused by the student to colleagues, faculty or any staff member.

- 15. Bulling of any sort.
- 16. In any type of suspicious activity, observed

Procedural Due Process:

The college Discipline committee shall be the authority to deal with all discipline matters. All cases of indiscipline shall be referred to the Discipline Committee.

Conduct of Discipline Committee:

The discipline committee shall ensure that the proper procedures as laid down are observed:

- a. Written notice on a prescribed date, time, and place shall be issued for appearance before the disciplinary committee.
- b. The student shall have time to respond to charges against him/her and submit a written declaration to the committee of discipline.
- c. A record of a recommendation hearing shall be transmitted to the competent authority for approval thereof.
- d. Decision of any disciplinary action shall be notified.

Penalties for indiscipline

If the disciplinary committee is satisfied that an act of indiscipline has been committed, it may impose penalties according to the gravity of the case resulting in expulsion, exclusion from activity, rustication, suspension, warning, disciplinary probation, loss of privileges including cancellation of admission

The library and reading room shall remain open during the prescribed hours.


Books and Journals will be issued to students only on deposit of their College Identity cards with the librarian.
